Road Funding Package/State Budget:

- The Michigan Cannabis Industry Association is challenging the new 24% marijuana tax which is expected to be \$420 million of the Neighborhood Road Funding package. The filing will be heard on Tuesday, November 25th by Court of Claims Judge Sima Patel. More to come.

2025 Construction Summary: I have started to put together the public version of our construction summary. This presentation includes more financial information for the public. I will share this one with the board once it is completed.

Township Work: I attended Doyle, Manistique, and Hiawatha Township's meeting last week to present the estimates for their potential projects. Doyle and Manistique agreed to go to bid for their projects and Hiawatha will choose which project they will be doing next month. The estimated cost for these projects is about \$600,000.

Road Incorporation Policy: I have started to work on updating the road specification policy to incorporate the specifications we reviewed at the last meeting. We will bring that to you for approval after revisions are completed.
