BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purpose of the Regular Meetings shall be for the normal conduct of business of the Board of Road Commissioners and any other items brought to the Board's attention by the Board Members, Board Attorney, Managing Director and Business Administrator/Board Secretary

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Road Commissioners does hereby designate the Advisor and/or Pioneer Tribune as official newspapers to receive notices of meetings; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notices of meetings of the Board of Road Commissioners will be posted in the Schoolcraft County Road Commission Administration Office and posted on the website.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Road Commissioners reserves the right to adjourn or recess a meeting at any time to discuss such matters that may be considered in closed session. However, the Board will first adopt a resolution stating the general nature of the subject to be discussed, and, as precisely as possible, the time and circumstances under which disclosure to the public will be made; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in order to conduct its meetings properly and efficiently, the Board shall require the following procedures pertaining to public participation at Board meetings:

- Any individual desiring to speak shall give his or her name, address, and the group, if any, that is represented.
- The presentation shall be as brief as possible but no more than ten (10) minutes per individual.
- The Board vests in its chairman, or other presiding officer, authority to terminate the remarks of any individual if he/she deems it in the best interest of those present to do so.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that individuals or organizations desiring notification of Board Meetings shall request such notification through the Schoolcraft County Road Commission office and be charged an annual fee of \$25.00, paid in advance.

Public Comment:

Paul Walker, County Commissioner Chair, stated that he felt D. DuFour was on the right track proposing afternoon meetings for the SCRC board once per quarter. He asked the commissioners to reconsider that proposal.

He also commented that the recent newspaper article regarding the SCRC's Winter Operations was helpful and a good move on the SCRC's part, as it shows where tax dollars are going.

Discussed the ARPA money, noting that county talks are in progress to come up with an appropriate figure. The amount, which is expected to be substantial, is a top priority, as the SCRC is important to public safety.

Noted that the VFW secured \$68k to replace the roof. They are working on other craftsmanship issues as well. He felt this was moving in a positive direction and thanks the community for their generosity.

Commissioner K. Rochefort began discussion regarding the green flashing lights reserved for the city and county vehicles. He has seen some private vehicles with the green lights. J. Vanderville will look into the vehicle code / state statute.
