B. Bid Opening RFP 2022-01 Seney Salt Shed: Bids were opened for the Seney salt shed. Closner Construction and Sales submitted no bid. IMS bid \$1,126,667; Roy Ness Contracting and Sales bid \$1,011,750; and Johnson Brothers Construction bid \$1,141,780. The bids were tabled pending MDOT's review.

C. Approval of \$25 Safety Gift Card to Jack's Fresh Market:

- E. Interview Patrick English: An interview was conducted at the end of the meeting.
- F. Interview Jordan Burmeister: An interview was conducted at the end of the meeting.

9. Manager's Report:

Seney Township Meeting: I. Stampfly and J. Vanderville attended the meeting. Most of the concerns were on the truckline system and about ditching in Seney. The MDOT concerns were passed on to Kevin and the ditching concerns were outside of the ROW.

Mueller Township Meting: They did not have any comments or concerns regarding the roads.

Inwood Township Meeting. I. Stampfly presented a paved road system repair plan to the Board. They were very receptive.

Hiawatha Township Meeting: The Township Board did not approve the naming of Kipper's Landing. An estimate was presented for a parking lot on Island Lake Road for the public park. Gilbert feels it is in the ROW but the Road Commission disagrees.

Wolfe Road Irrigation Lines: This was discussed under 8D - Approval of Permit for Hanson Seed Farm.

Fall Safety Training: The training took place on October 26.

MDOT Roadside Parks: All roadside parks were closed October 26, 2021.

Pro-Fund Accounting: J. Vanderville has been working with R. Martin on updating the equipment and inventory modules within PFA.

Bridge Files: The file completions are due October 31, 2021.

Quarry Road Turnaround: The Road Commission is building a turnaround at the new road end because of the road abandonment.

10. Engineer's Report:

CR-433 Design: Final plans, notes, and specification package was submitted on October 15, 2021. According to MDOT, the project is scheduled for the March 4th letting.

CR-441 Construction: Final inspection occurred on October 22,2021. U.P. Engineers & Architects will proceed to finalize the paperwork side of the project and work towards final closeout.

FLAP Grants: Received some comments from the forest service. Made some updates to the applications based on their comments. Inwood Township was contacted on October 25, 2021 to see their interest in providing a letter of support in addition to the Forest Service. The Road Commission is on track to submit the applications by or before the deadline on December 15, 2021.

Category A – Transportation Economic Development Fund: Received response with great information from Doug Troyer. I. Stampfly will work towards finalizing the letter of interest that is due November 10, 2021.

Township Work: Presented paved road reports to Doyle and Inwood townships. The reports were well received and the Townships look forward to the gravel reports coming next spring/summer. Continuing to work on other township road reports. Currently, Thompson, Mueller, Seney, and Germfask Townships are ready to be presented. Hiawatha and Manistique Township will be ready once pictures are added to the presentations.

5-Year RTF Outlook: Have been planning the future RTF projects. The 5-year summary and estimated dollar amounts are included in the board packets.

County Road 448 at Stutts Creek: U.P. Engineers & Architects (UPEA) stated that the bridge plans are ready for a GI review meeting with MDOT. UPEA will work on scheduling the meeting as soon as possible. UPEA hopes to have the project into MDOT early enough to get a March bid letting date.

County Wide Sign Project: I. Stampfly is continuing to work on closeout. He has reviewed quantities and put all IDR's into Field Manager. His goal is to have the project submitted to MDOT for final review in the next few weeks.

11. Department Heads:

Tanya Hoar, Finance Director: T. Hoar informed the Board of the renovation done to the front office and the Finance and HR meeting she attended.

Roger Martin, Shop Foreman: R. Martin discussed the work being done to E-538 and that the shop has been preparing the trucks for winter.

Kim Rochefort, Road Foreman: K. Rochefort stated that the work on Hass Road has been completed. The crew have also been working on sand pockets on the Thunder Lake Road; they have opened the 8-mile cut across; and the salt and sand pile are ready for winter. Night crew will start on Sunday.

Troy Bassett, County Commissioner: T. Bassett discussed a new contract with the zoning administrator. He also updated the Board on the American Rescue Plan. The Board may hire consultants to help them appropriate the funds.

J. Vanderville asked T. Bassett why the letter she sent to the Board regarding the survey estimate for Gulliver Lake was never discussed at the last meeting or even brought up as correspondence. T. Bassett said he would check on it.
