




B. Bid Opening RFP 2021-07 M28 Tree Clearing: There were no bids to open.

MCRCSIP Refund: MCRCSIP refunded \$15 Million back to its members, Schoolcraft CRC's share of that was \$73,496.

Grand St. Seney Township: There has been some confusion on the ownership of the culvert on Grand St. that has failed. Kevin Gouza has requested a cost share to have the culvert inspected. They will run a camera from MDOT's manhole on M28 south and then from our manhole on the back street north, to determine where it ties in.

Gulliver Lake Association: I received notification from Alan Kilar, GLPOA President to proceed with establishment of the drainage district and assessment district of the Gulliver Lake Dam.

Schoolcraft County Application Drive: Amy Kraatz with MiWorks has invited us to submit information for an application drive that will take place August 18, 2021 Tanya has started the process of getting out open positions registered with the event.
