9. Manager's Report:

GovDeals: The grader (G96) was sold for \$38,000. As of July 6th, we are still waiting for payment. A payment reminder was sent July 14th.

The tanker was offered internally and sold for the \$500.00 reserve.

2026 – 2027 Salt Orders: The early fill was awarded to Compass Minerals at a price of \$89.23/ton (\$80,307).

The seasonal backup was awarded to Compass Minerals at a price of \$93.13/ton (\$79,16050).

These are significant increases over last year's pricing.

- Early fill increase of 21%; Seasonal backup increase of 14%.
- Overall increase in cost with additional tonnage and increased pricing is approximately \$35,500 (Total Salt \$159,500).

10. Engineer's Report:

There is still work to be done on the township roads. Due to the high heat we were experiencing, we didn't want to put any heavy equipment on the roads.

CR-455 is shouldered, painted, and the concrete driveway was poured.

Clear Lake and Thunder Lake shouldering was completed along with pavement markings.

There will be gravel lifts to be completed later this month or early August.
